

JUNK CAR VARIANCE APPLICATION

INFORMATION FOR THE APPLICANT: Property owners may store up to two vehicles on their property for which the license has expired for a period of 45 days, or a car being stored in the open for 45 days with the granting of a variance by the Planning Commission. Both of the vehicles must be operable. In no circumstance may the vehicles be in an inoperable condition as defined in Section 7.2 c. of the Zoning Ordinance.

If the variance is granted by the Planning Commission, the following conditions must be met by the property owner: (1) both vehicles must be stored in the back yard; and (2) both vehicles must be stored within the confines of a wood fence 6 feet high that prevents the viewing of the contents from external view. The property owner must pay the current fee for a variance before the variance can be considered, and upon the approval of the variance a building permit fee for the fence.
