

CITY OF BABBITT
SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING
January 12, 2011

The Special Meeting of the Babbitt City Council was reconvened at 7:07 p.m. this date.

Present were Councilors Fitzpatrick, Hoheisel, Lassi, Marinaro, and Mayor Anderson. Also present was Attorney Mitch Brunfelt.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the vacant position in the Administrative office and review a preliminary complaint against a City employee.

It was Council consensus to direct Attorney Brunfelt to look over the City Clerk-Treasurer and Deputy Clerk-Treasurer job descriptions. There were questions regarding the Clerk-Treasurer being involved with union negotiations, while being unionized. The matter would be discussed further at the January 19th Council meeting.

It was moved by Lassi, supported by Marinaro, to allow Klegstad to utilize flex-time to be used within a month's time until a contract is in place.

Motion declared carried.

The decision to charge the Babbitt Figure Skating Club \$4,500.00 and \$1,500.00 to East Range Hockey for Arena use for the 2010-2011 season was tabled until the next Council meeting of January 19th.

It was moved by Anderson, supported by Marinaro, to close the meeting at 7:37 p.m. for the purpose of discussing the preliminary City employee complaint.

Motion declared carried.
