

CITY OF BABBITT
Parks and Recreation Board
February 9, 2011

The Regular Meeting of the Babbitt Parks and Recreation Board was called to order this date at 5:03 p.m.

Present for roll call were Members Lind-Chamberlin, Muellerleile, Marinaro, Chairman Lossing and Mayor Anderson. Student Representative Kelly Serena arrived at 5:29 p.m. and Member Jaeger arrived at 5:31 p.m.

Absent was Member Zupancich.

It was moved by Marinaro, supported by Lind-Chamberlin, to approve the minutes of the Special Parks and Recreation Board Meeting of January 12, 2011. Motion carried.

Rich Posey of the Street Department gave an update of the arena project. The locker rooms have been cleaned and washed down with a power washer, the matting has been replaced and the old matting has been stored in the back of the arena. Currently two outside lighting issues are being worked on. Everything should be ready to go for the adult hockey tournament planned for February 19th.

It was moved by Chairman Lossing, supported by Mayor Anderson, to accept and authorize the bills as submitted. Motion carried.


Discussion followed on the needs of a Recreation Department Employee and Mission Statement. Upon reviewing and providing input for updates to the City of Babbitt Recreation Coordinator Position Description on file, it was moved by Marinaro, supported by Lind-Chamberlin, to recommend to the Babbitt City Council to post a part time, 32 hours per week, Recreation Coordinator position for a two week period. Beginning salary would be based on qualifications of the candidates and the City of Babbitt Position Classification Plan Job Evaluation Point System. The candidate would work under the direction of the Parks and Recreation Board for day to day operations with referral to the City Council for resolution to more serious problems and issues. A request was made to have the City Attorney review the wording of a Mission Statement as the Recreation Board is presently an Advisory Board and no longer a Commission. Motion carried.

It was moved by Chairman Lossing, supported by Marinaro, to waive the rental fee for use of the gym for the Miss Babbitt Committee. Motion carried.


It was moved by Chairman Lossing, supported by Marinaro, to adjourn at 6:25 p.m. Motion carried.
