

**City of Babbitt
Parks and Recreation Board

The Regular Meeting of the Babbitt Parks and Recreation Board was called to order at 5:30 p.m. by Acting Chairman, Ron Marinaro.

Old Business

City gardens were discussed along with the history of the City Gardeners.

The fishing pier was pulled from the water for repair. Two more sections are in need of repair.

Coordinator Scherer gave an update on the ice arena. Presently no power at the arena, the underground wire is burned. Minnesota Power is putting an entire new service in at the school and the arena feed will be repaired at that time. The cost to the City will be replacement of switches.

The meter at the football field has been turned off which brings a savings of \$25.00 per month.

New Business

Handicapped bathroom at the beach was discussed. It will be explored and revisited at a later date.

Information boards at the beach entrances were discussed.

Pop machines for the beach were discussed. Coordinator Scherer and Zupancich will contact Coke and Pepsi.

Frontier has been called to repair Coordinator Scherer's phone line.

Options for rafts at the beach were discussed. Coordinator Scherer and Zupancich will contact vendors. The present trampoline rafts at the beach cost \$4,000.
