

CITY OF BABBITT  
PUBLIC SAFETY MEETING  
October 26, 2011

Discussion was held on *Rules of the Road* for volunteer fire and ambulance personnel. The Fire Chief had talked to his members about this about a month ago and that it was going to be watched.

After discussion on having the members of the Fire Department to have EVOC training, it was moved by Chase, supported by Negley, to bring the issue to the Council.
